



## Alice Delphine Howell

October 10, 1920 - March 29, 2014

Alice Delphine Howell, 93, passed away on March 29, 2014 in her residence at Swan Creek Retirement Village. Alice was born in Defiance Ohio on October 10, 1920 to Elwood and Atha Howell.

She was a graduate of Defiance High School class of 1938 and the Toledo Hospital School of Nursing where she became a registered nurse. She was employed at Defiance Hospital and Magruder Hospital in Port Clinton. She served her country honorably during World War II as a 1st Lieutenant in the 101st Evac Hospital where General Patton frequently visited the wounded soldiers. Later Alice attended Case Western Reserve University where she received her B.S. degree. She returned to Toledo Hospital to work as an O.B. supervisor where she finished her career in the School of Nursing teaching freshman students about aging. She was a longtime member of Fairgreen Presbyterian Church.

Surviving are her sister-in-law Patricia Howell of Stow Ohio; nieces Beth Howell and Patti Howell of Akron. She was preceded in death by her two brothers.
