Christos Spiros Theodorou, 62, of Sylvania Township, Ohio died Tuesday June 5th, 2018 in the early morning at Hospice of Northwest Ohio. Ending his 15 month battle with Leukemia. Born in 1955 in Alea, Greece, to Spiros and Demetra Theodorou. In 1969 he moved to the United States with his family at the age of 14 and graduated from Roy C. Start High school in 1974.

Married to Patricia "Patti" (Slates), the love of his life for almost 42 years this June. Loving her so much, they married twice. The first time in 1976 and the second time in 1982. Chris would jokingly tell people that he had two children, from two different marriages, but both have the same Mom!

Chris started working for Maumee Valley Heating and Air Conditioning in 1982 and took ownership in 1995. He has been generously donating time and furnaces to hundreds of families through radio station 101.5 The River's annual giveaway "Furnace for a Family" and many other charitable organizations in Toledo.
