Howard Hunt, 82, formerly of Toledo, Ohio, resided in Oakland and Rowan County Kentucky. Howard was born in Majestic, Kentucky on October 26, 1932, to Phil Hunt and Thurse Hunt Wolford. He died of cardiac arrest in Lexington, Kentucky, on Sunday, October 25, 2015, one day shy of his 83rd birthday. Howard was an alumnus of the University of Kentucky where he received his Masters of Education. For 30 years, he worked in Toledo Public Schools: teaching Business at Macomber, Louella Cummings and he retired as a visiting teacher. He also worked for the Toledo Teacher's Credit Union and Man Power. Howard loved being outdoors and derived great joy from keeping up his Kentucky properties.
