Isabelle and Victor adopted their daughter Victoria Lynn in 1953. Isabelle delighted in using her sewing skills to keep her daughter the best dressed girl in Toledo. Following her father in laws death, Isabelle cared for mother Stelzer for almost twenty years. She enjoyed her hobby as a dressmaker and seamstress and was able to turn that into a thriving home business. She started a sewing club over 50 years ago, only slowing down the past six months as old age and illness intruded. Her creativity was evident everywhere from fashion design and home d?cor to gardening, cooking and baking. Her potluck group met regularly for over 40 years. She had a close circle of friends who were drawn to her kind spirit and generous nature. She and her husband initiated the Goddard Rd. block party, an annual event with their close knit neighbors in the 3100 block of Goddard Rd. They were also founding members of St. Clements' Church and active parishioners at St. Pius X since 1958. She was president of the Sultanas, Ladies Club of the Alhambra, and active in the mothers club at St. Pius X and St. Ursula Academy. Leaving behind to cherish her memory are her loving husband Victor; daughter Victoria (Ibrahim) Ismail; grandchildren, Hyder (Zeina), Sadig, Sabrina (Mohamad) Moussa, Mehdi and Ali. Isabelle was the number one Sitto! She loved her grandchildren more than anything and they too love her dearly.
