Margaret E. (Frahn) Wineland, age 88, of Toledo, OH lost her gallant battle with adenocarcinoma on Sunday , December 4, 2016 under home hospice care.

Margaret was the 6th born child of 10 born to George and Dorothy (Sullings) Frahn, Sr., on June 4, 1928 in Reno Beach, OH. She graduated in the field of retailing from Whitney Vocational High School in 1946 with her first job as selling hosiery at LaSalles Department Store in downtown Toledo for 38 cents/hour.

Margaret met and married Jack E. Wineland on July 30 1949 and they just celebrated their 67th wedding anniversary this past July.

Margaret was a long-time member of Pilgrim Congregational Church of The United Church of Christ and an active volunteer and member of the St. Luke's Hospital Women's Guild. She worked at St. Vincent Medical Center as an information clerk for years. She remained an active bowler on leagues in the Toledo area for over 50 years, She was an aggressive and loyal supporter of the University of Michigan football team and enjoyed attending several games in their stadium over the years with various fellow family supporters. Her remarkable aptitude in the kitchen was a highlight of any invitation to her house – she was the family “dial-a-cook”.

Margaret, however, was most devoted and most passionate about family. She taught and lived the family values she embraced every day of her life – compassion, honesty, forgiveness, love, and faith.

Margaret was preceded in death by her parents George Frahn, Sr., and Dorothy Frahn, her brothers, George Frahn, Jr., Bill (Jean), Frank (Patricia), Jim (Joanne), Joe (Brenda) and sisters, Betty (Blackie) Dessert and Lola (Paul) English. She is survived by brothers Jay and Dick, both of Florida, and sister-in-law, Maxine (George Frahn, Jr.) Frahn.

She was also predeceased by daughter, Debra (Thomas) Taylor and son-in-law Darryl
