She attended St. Stephen's School and Central Catholic High School. In 1932 Rose graduated from the Toledo Hospital School of Nursing as a registered nurse, then practiced her profession until her retirement. In 1938 she moved to New York where she remained for the rest of her life. She worked at New York Hospital-Cornell Medical Center, Sloan Kettering Memorial Hospital, and Roosevelt Hospital., followed by many years as a private duty nurse. Rose was known as a very kind and generous person who gave freely to her family in Toledo and to her many friends in New York.
