(Margaret) Ann Foote died Saturday, October 24, 2009 at Heartland of Perrysburg. Ann was born in Bowling Green, Ohio to Fred and Edna Foote on December 1, 1918. She was the youngest of eight children. She eventually moved to Toledo and graduated from Libbey High School in 1936. Ann moved to Detroit in 1939 and was a devoted member of Central United Methodist Church for many years. She was also a member of the League of Women Voters in both Detroit and Toledo. Ann was a devoted friend and executive secretary to James C. B. Handley who had his offices in the Fisher Building. She retired and moved to Sun City, Arizona in 1979 and then returned to Toledo in 1985 to be near her sister, Betty Goodwillie. Ann was a woman of strong convictions and marched with Dr. Martin Luther King in Detroit in the 60's. She will be remembered for her sweet nature, always cheerful and kind with a charming sense of humor. Ann was preceded in death by her parents, siblings and a great nephew, Kevin Layton. She is survived by many loving nieces and nephews and her dear friend, Nancy Minder.
