



Carl H. Keeran

December 15, 1938 - July 23, 2018

Carl H. Keeran, age 79, of West Toledo, passed away on July 23, 2018 at St. Anne Hospital. He was born December 15, 1938 to Carl and Fernande Keeran in Toledo. He was a graduate of Woodward High School (1956) and University of Toledo (1961), where he earned a B.S. degree and was a member of Tau Kappa Epsilon (TKE) social fraternity, Gamma Nu chapter.

Carl's primary employers included, Continental Aviation & Engineering, Kaiser Jeep Corp., Data Corp (Dayton, Ohio-government contractor), Owens-Illinois (retiree) and Oracle Corp (Redwood City, CA). His primary expertise was in Information Technology (IT). Positions included, systems, applications and contract programming, operations research analyst, information retrieval analyst, technical writer, hardware/software infrastructure research, planning and management, project leader, internal Owens-Illinois IT technology consultant, Oracle senior consultant (road warrior and webmaster). In addition, as an independent contractor, Carl performed targeted consulting services to a variety of clients.

Carl (and his wife, Bobbie) was an in depth (volunteer) administrative coordinator and fundraiser for the 501-C3 Toledo Area Wheelchair Athletic Association from 1980 to 1990. Better known for it's primary endeavor, the Toledo Silver Streaks wheelchair basketball team that made the Final Four of the then 180 team National Wheelchair Basketball Association (NWBA) 3

times in 10 years.

Carl is survived by his loving wife, Roberta "Bobbie"; daughter, Denise; and son, Ned Barnes Jr. He was preceded in death by his mother, Fernande in 1980; father, Carl in 1986; and half-brother, Russ Jackson in 1988.
