



## Carl R. Schuttenberg

January 15, 1917 - January 30, 2010

Carl R. Schuttenberg, 93, formerly of Toledo, passed away on Saturday January 30, 2010 in the Dublin Retirement Village in Dublin Ohio where he relocated in 2006. He was born in Cleveland Ohio on January 15, 1917 to Martha and Theodore Schuttenberg. Carl served his country honorably during WWII and was stationed in France and Germany. He was inducted into the U.S. Army in 1942 and served in the 14th armored division obtaining a WOJG status prior to being discharged in 1946. In 1957 he began his career in Cleveland at the Goodyear Tire and Rubber Co. moving to Toledo in 1964. While employed, he achieved the "Life Masters" award from the American Contract Bridge League. He retired in 1982. Carl was an avid fisherman and especially enjoyed fishing in the Georgian Bay in Canada. He was an avid sports fan, the Ohio State Buckeyes and Cleveland Browns were his favorite teams. He and his wife Chris, enjoyed traveling extensively together throughout the United States. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Greater Toledo. He is survived by his loving wife of 65 years, Christine Schuttenberg; and daughter Karen Schuttenberg of Dublin Ohio. He was preceded in death by his sibling Theodore Schuttenberg and sister Ruth Belia.
