Charles M. Ganzert, 68, of Lambertville MI, passed away on Tuesday, January 23, 2018, at his home. He was born October 23, 1949, in Toledo and was the son of Charles and Anna Ganzert. Charles worked at Toledo Painters Supply for 9 years. He then worked for RMF, a division of Phillips Services, where he worked for 8 years before going on disability with Multiple System Atrophy.

Chuck was a longtime member of the Most Blessed Sacrament Church, where he served as a Eucharist Minister and was a member of the Teamster Union, Local #20. Chuck was also a member of the NHRA. He built his own race car ('79 Camero) and raced at Milan Raceway, in Michigan. Chuck also cared for injured animals brought to him from the neighborhood kids.
