



## Charles N. Moulopoulos

June 24, 1922 - February 21, 2012

Charles N. Moulopoulos "Doc" 89, passed away on Tuesday February 21, in Heartland of Waterville. Doc served his country honorably in both World War Two and the Korean War. He served as a Captain in the Air Force and in The Medical and Dental Care Corps. He graduated from the University of Toledo and the University of Louisville Dental School. He was a member of Alpha Phi Omega, Beta Delta Dental Honorary, and OKU Dental Honorary. He practiced dentistry in Toledo for 25 years. Doc was one of three founding members of Belleview Investors a commercial development company. He was a former member of the Toledo Museum of Art, The Toledo Club, Sylvania Country Club, and the Toledo Tennis Club. He is survived by his loving wife of 55 years, Gloria Moulopoulos; his three children and greatest joys, Nicholas Moulopoulos, Harry (Kathaleen) Moulopoulos and Rena (Henry) Neville; his greatest treasures were his eight grandchildren, Samara, Harry, Alexa, Aristotle, Athena, Hailey, Helene and Christopher.
