Charles "Chuck" Shaffer of Toledo, Ohio passed away at home on Sunday, September 10, 2017. He was born in Toledo, Ohio on May 7, 1953. Chuck attended Blessed Sacrament Elementary School, St. Francis de Sales High School, and was a proud 1976 graduate of Marquette University in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Chuck worked for the Lucas County Treasurers office from 1977 until 1990. For the past 27 years, Chuck was employed by Judge Jack Puffenberger as the court administrator for the Lucas County Probate Court.

Chuck was preceded in death by his father, Russel E. Shaffer DDS, and his mother, Patricia Shaffer Greenen. He is survived by his brother, Russel Shaffer (Carol) and his sister, Barbara Nichols (Neal).
