



Costas Loizou

January 20, 1921 - March 7, 2011

Loizou Costas "Gus", a resident of Toledo, was reunited with God on March 7, 2011 following a brief illness. Costas was born on the sun drenched island of Cyprus in the small village of Agridaki on January 20th, 1921. At the age of 13 he moved to the capital city of Lefkosia and became an apprentice cobbler. He later immigrated to the United States as a young man in 1948. Upon arriving in the United States he came to Toledo to work with his uncle at the Coney Island restaurant in downtown Toledo. He worked for many years in Toledo, but moved his family to Florida in 1959 and later returned to Toledo in the late 1960s this time as a partner with his uncle at the Coney Island. He retired in 1980. He was a member of the Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Cathedral in Toledo. For many years he volunteered at the Church's annual Greek American Festival, making the delicious Greek salads everyone enjoyed. Costas enjoyed spending time with his family and in later years called the time with his grandchildren the light of his life. He also enjoyed gardening and traveling. He is survived by his wife Maroulla and his daughter Harriette Mattson of Key Largo, Florida, his son Andy (Patty) Loizou of Toledo, daughter Christina (Michael) Temple of Toledo; 5 grandchildren, 3 great grandchildren, and many nieces and nephews.
