Daisy Margaret Belair passed away at Sunset House on November 4, 2010 at the grand age of 104. Margaret was born in Massillon, Ohio on April 28, 1906 to Charles and Lillian Nicewander. The family moved to Toledo in 1912. "Peg" met her future husband, Earl Belair while visiting her hairdresser, Earl's sister, and love led to a marriage that lasted 57 years. Margaret attended old Woodward Technical School, where she took comptometer (the original computer) training, and then went on to Davis Business School. She was employed by Willys Overland and worked in the factory accounting department. During the War Years she was a "Rosie the Riveter" on what was called the Powder Hoist. She retired in 1968 after over 45 years of service, and was the oldest living retiree of the UAW Jeep plant. Margaret was a member of First Evangelical and Reformed Church at Cherry & Moore until it closed. She will always be remembered as an unconditionally loving person, whose most treasured possession was her family and the times she spent with them.
