Daniel Dionyssiou, age 63, died tragically in a motor vehicle accident, leaving behind so many people that loved and adored him. Anyone that knew Dan, knew what an amazing man he was. “The Fasha”, “Danny D”, “Papou”, “Dan the Man”, however you knew him, whatever you called him...he was there for everyone.
