Denny Amrhein, 73, passed away unexpectedly Friday December 2, 2022. He was born March 17, 1949 to Ralph and Alice (Gilmore) in Toledo. He graduated from Central Catholic High School in 1967.

Denny met Shirley Irvine 59 years ago, they started dating in 1965 while attending Central Catholic High School and eventually married.. He attended Adrian College in Adrian, Mich., and the University of Toledo, but left both before graduating to pursue a career as a salesman. He started his career at the former Papenhagen Oldsmobile on West Central Avenue and became one of the highest-selling Oldsmobile dealers in the country during his 12-year tenure. Denny then became a Ford dealer in Wauseon before moving to Grogan's Towne Dodge in west Toledo in 1990. He was the owner of Grogan's Towne Chrysler Jeep Dodge Ram and Charlie's Dodge Chrysler Jeep Ram in Maumee for the last several years.

Denny is survived by his children, Valerie (Dave) Valentine; Denny P.
