Dolores Elizabeth (Richter) Darr, 100, formerly of Toledo passed away Sunday, August 9, 2015. She was born June 11, 1915, to Louis and Edith Richter of Akron, OH. In 1921, she moved to Fort Dodge, IA, where she graduated from Sacred Heart School. They returned to Akron, OH and Dolores worked in the office of General Tire & Rubber, as a stenographer, bookkeeper and typist.

Dolores met William M. Darr, from Oak Harbor, OH, and married him in August, 1952. They moved to Toledo where she attended St. Catherine of Siena and Blessed Sacrament Parishes. Dolores was also a bookkeeper for the Toledo Barber School for 4 years.

She was active at the Eleanor Kahle Senior Center, Blessed Sacrament Altar Guild and Bereavement Choir.

Dolores was a very gifted homemaker. Her talents included cake decorating, china painting, singing and playing the piano. She and her husband had traveled to Europe and many of the states, including Alaska and Hawaii. Dolores was very active in pinochle groups and played into her nineties. She

lived in her own home until she was 98 years old. She then moved into Orchard Villa, following a stroke.
