Doris A. Holden, 92 of Toledo, died on Sunday, October 29, 2017. Doris was born on November 30, 1924 in Monette, Arkansas to the late J.P. and Margie Moore. Doris had six sisters and three brothers whom she deeply loved. She spent her growing up years in Northeast Arkansas with her family.
