It is with sadness that we announce the passing of Dorothy M. Elliott on May 17, 2014 at the age of 89 at St. John's West Shore Hospital, Westlake, Ohio.

She was born on September 15, 1924 to Emiel and Irma Popelier. Born and raised in Toledo, Ohio, she grew up in St. Agnes Parish and later graduated from Devilbiss High School. She worked in primarily administrative positions after high school and into her married life: traffic manager for the Medical Depot, bookkeeper for Dr. Borer's medical office, and assistant personnel manager at City Auto Stamping. Her favorite position was working with Sister Elizabeth at St. Catherine's Grade School where she saw her daughter Nancy and her future husband, Larry Kovacs "perform" as Mary and Joseph in the 1st Grade Christmas play. Four years ago, she moved to Avon Lake, Ohio to be near her daughter, Nancy Kovacs and son-in-law, Larry Kovacs.

Her husband, Glen James Elliott grew up in the same St. Agnes neighborhood. While they were growing up there was no real attraction. After Glen came back from WWII, he swept Dorothy off her feet and they were married on September 11, 1948. She loved spending time with her family, doing crossword puzzles and reading.

Dorothy was preceded in death by her husband, Glen James, her parents, and her sisters, Alma Thomas and Alice Albert. She is survived by her daughter Nancy Kovacs (Larry) and grandchildren, Katie Kovacs Hire (Andy) and Kyle Kovacs (Jennie). She had two (twin) great granddaughters, Eliza J. and McKee E. Hire.
