



## Dorothy Gagnet

September 20, 1919 - December 28, 2010

Dorothy M. Gagnet, 91, a lifelong resident of Toledo, died Tuesday, December 28, 2010. She was the daughter of Thomas and Verona Mitchell. Dorothy was a graduate of Lake High School, where she was captain of the debate team and active in theatre productions. Dorothy was a member of Saint Catherine of Siena Parish for over 60 years, serving on the Community Concerns and Prayer Network committees. She was a Cub Scout Den Mother and contributor to Saint Catherine's School. She was also a board member of Saint Anthony's Villa and delivered Mobile Meals for many years. In addition, she supported the Cherry Street Mission, Helping Hands of Saint Louis, and the Visitation Sisters. Dorothy married John Gagnet 3 days before he left for basic training for the D Day invasion. She moved to New York City to be closer to John while he awaited orders to go overseas. Dorothy landed a job at Henri Bendel in New York where she met many celebrities, including the Duchess of Windsor. Dorothy and John were married 55 years and returned to New York many times during their marriage. Dorothy was a devoted wife, mother and grandmother. She was preceded in death by her husband John. She is survived by her sons Thomas (Janice) of Toledo, James (Karen) of Dayton, John of Cincinnati, daughter Suzanne (Michael) Fischer of Cincinnati; grandchildren Katharine Gagnet, Ellen Gagnet, Claire Fischer, Sarah (Aaron Fleming) Fischer, Michael Fischer, Tracy (Sid) Sosa, Nichole (Chris) Rall, James Gagnet, Atalie Gagnet, Coco Gagnet, Hector Gagnet; great grandchildren Emerson Sosa, Coen Sosa, Isabel Rall, and Jude Rall.
