Eleanor R. (Wells) Brazzill, 82, passed away Tuesday, March 11, 2008. She was preceded in death by her husband, Francis O. "Bud"; son, Thomas F.; brothers, Norbert and Joseph Wells. She was born in Toledo September 4, 1925 to Charles and Mary (Schetter) Wells. This hard-working devoted family matriarch was previously employed at the Toledo Blade and after her marriage was secretary for her husband's business, Brazzill Painting and Decorating Co. After Bud's death in 1977 she served as secretary at St. Jude Catholic School and Central Catholic High School. Eventually employed as office manager for Lucas County CARES (Chemical Abuse Reduced Through Education and Services) and Lucas County Courts Juvenile Detention Center. Eleanor organized several Red Ribbon Rallies and "Just Say No" events in the late 1980's and early 90's. For 34 years she was active at Blessed Sacrament Church serving as lector, Stephens Minister and lay distributor. Surviving are her children, Sharon (John) Woll of Cincinnati, Kathleen (Bill) Aubry of Upper Sandusky, Dianne M. Brazzill of Westmont, IL, Linda (Brett) Langston of Toledo and Patricia (Dan) Kendall of Scarsdale, NY; 11 grandchildren, 3 great grandchildren; sisters, Marian Wells, Mildred (William) Maier, Theresa Lyons and brother, Chuck (Maryellen) Wells of Crestview, FL. The Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated 1 PM Friday at Blessed Sacrament Church.
