Eleanor G. Rose, age 90, a longtime south Toledo resident and former resident of Luthercrest, passed on to eternal life to join the Lord and her husband, Wilbur on Thursday October 1, 2009, at Heatherdowns Rehabilitation and Residential Care Center.
