March 1, 1925 - June 29, 2023

Emma Lois Beeler passed into the presence of the Lord on Thursday, June 29, 2023.

She was born to Miley and Cecil (Kelly) Kilburn in Lawrenceburg, TN, March 1, 1925. She was 98 years old.

While her future husband, Roy, was serving in the European Theatre during WWII, Emma was a Rosie the Riveter in Canton, Ohio. After returning to Tennessee and Roy returned from the war, they were married February 15, 1946 in Decatur, Alabama. They moved to Toledo, Ohio in 1951. She devoted most of her adult life to raising her family which spanned the course of 42 years. She was a gifted seamstress and phenomenal cook and enjoyed her hobby of gardening until she was 91. But nothing brought her more joy than family gatherings, especially having time with her grandchildren. (Although dress shopping at Dillard's was a close second.)

Emma was a member of Liberty Baptist Church in Toledo since 1955. After retiring from JC Penny Distribution Center in 1985, her and Roy enjoyed traveling to see family well into their 80's.

Emma was a wonderful care giver to her husband, especially the last eight years of his life. It gives our family great peace to know they are reunited once again.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband Roy, her brothers; Clemon, Willie Paul, Charles, TJ Kilburn, Miley Jr. and sister Norma Rene Irvin.
