Florine Fasnacht Corbin Corisis, 95, passed away peacefully, October 28, 2024 at Sunset House.

She was born to Paul and Annabelle (West) Fasnacht in 1929 in Toledo and raised with siblings Paula Fasnacht (Varner) and Paul. She met Tommy Corbin Corisis in kindergarten she knew he was “the one” and married him in 1951 spending 51 years together. Florine was always smiling, this fashionista began modeling at age 8 and was featured on the Lion Store Teen board! An amazing honor at that age.

She was 1947 graduate of Woodward High School who participated in choir, drama class and was an energetic majorette. Florine sang live on WSPD radio’s Kiddie Carnival program and sang in the Ken Holland Choir, the church choir and at special events.

Florine received her Bachelor’s in Education from UT while raising four children and hosting Stanley Home Products parties while Tommy worked opposite shifts at the factory to share in raising the children. She retired from teaching 2nd grade at Greenwood School and Tom from General Tire. She and Tom stayed active in retirement by doing volunteer work and attending monthly Class of 47 and teachers’ luncheons. Florine and Tom maintained lifelong friendships spending Winters in their home in Ft. Myers in the same community as Sis for 10 years until Tommy’s death in 2002. Florine moved to The Woodlands/Sunset House campus where she lived for the last 14 years.

She created strong bonds with the staff who cared for her during those years.

Florine had pizzazz with a sparkling personality that would light up a room. She loved her family, music, teaching and singing brought her joy her entire life.
