In the Army he served in the European theatre, during World War II as a radar trouble shooter. He landed in Normandy "D-day 1". "Red" married his love Pearl M. Moore (1923-2002) on March 11, 1946, and raised two daughters and a son. Frank accepted his living Lord and Savior in 1953 and served him as an officer, treasure, and moderator many years at Riverside Baptist Church, Toledo, OH and Cass Road Baptist Church, Maumee, OH. "Red" joined his father and operated Gilbert's Garage for many years. Later he worked for Gross Automotive. After his "1st" retirement he worked as a courier for 12 years for Mercy Integrated Labs.
