



## George Franklin "Papa George" McCormack

March 1, 1933 - October 1, 2018

George Franklin McCormack of Toledo Ohio passed away Monday morning October 1st, 2018.

George was in the care of St. Anne's Cancer Center, ProMedica Hospice, his loving family and trusted aid, Kim Abbas.
