July 2, 1923 - February 18, 2011

Grace Ruth (Mohr) Scherting, age 87, passed away on Friday, February 18, 2011, at home surrounded by her children. The daughter of Alton and Helen Mohr, she was born July 02, 1923 fourth of ten children in Toledo. She was a graduate of St. Ursula Academy, and attended Davis College. Grace joined the Navy as a Wave during WWII as a Storekeeper, first at the Pentagon, and then at Pearl Harbor. After her discharge she returned to Toledo and worked at the Dana Corporation. She married Harry Scherting on October 15, 1949. Grace stayed at home and cared for her nine children until they were in school and then started her career with the United State's Post Office retiring in 1988 after 24 years of service. Grace enjoyed her time with her family, her faith, and as a member of the VFW Post #2898 and Catholic War Veterans.
