Harry J. Badhorn, 76, of Toledo, passed away Friday, August 10, 2007, at his home. He was born October 4, 1930, to Harry John and Marie (Erard) Badhorn in Toledo. Harry was a member of the 1948 graduating class of Central Catholic High School. He honorably served his country as a member of the Air Force and was stationed in Okinawa, Japan, during the Korean War.
