After finishing an apprenticeship in machine tool design, he worked for Junkers Aircraft Company as an airframe designer.? In 1938, he was drafted into the German Air Force and actively flew with the Edelweiss Stuka Squadron KG51 for the duration of World War II.? In May 1940 he married Mathilde Weegmann in Duerrmenz/Muehlacker, Germany and 50 years later celebrated their Golden Wedding Anniversary in the same church, which was filled to capacity with friends and neighbors. ??? In 1953, he brought his family to Toledo, Ohio, where he worked for City Machine & Tool (Sheller Globe) until his retirement in 1980.? He was an active member of the Toledo Schwaben Verein since 1954 and was active in the German American Festival Society.? Other memberships included the GAF Retirees, Sylvania Pyramid Masonic Lodge, Scottish Rite, Zenobia Shrine, Toledo Lions Club, and Sylvania Moose Lodge.? He enjoyed fishing and gardening. ???
