Inez graduated from Rosary Cathedral School, and St. Ursula Academy, and attended St. Vincent Hospital School of Nursing. She was Office Manager for a pediatric physicians group for many years. Inez was a member of Our Lady Queen of the Most Holy Rosary Cathedral Parish. She participated in BLUE, an outreach ministry to people living in the cathedral area inviting residents to join the cathedral parish, a ministry which also provided services to the elderly and inform. Always dedicated to the cathedral community, she volunteered in the parish office during her retirement years. Strong in her Catholic faith, she was supportive of multiple Catholic missions and had a deep devotion to the rosary. Inez was a positive and cheerful person who loved to celebrate holidays, especially Christmas. Her home was a show place of decorations every Christmas Season. Surviving are her sisters, Sister Mary Johanna Leyland, OSU and Sister Mary Joachim Leyland, OSU, and many nieces and nephews.
