



## J. Perry Tucker

Jewell Perry Tucker, 86, of Toledo, died on Sunday, June 24, 2007. Mr. Tucker, known by most people as Perry, was born in Bon Aqua, TN, on December 17, 1920 and was the son of the late Jesse and Cora (Cochran) Tucker. On January 4, 1947, Perry married Lavon Saneholtz and they celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary this past January. Perry served with the U.S. Army Medical Corps during World War II. Mr. Tucker was retired from the Kroger Co., where he worked for 30 years, as a store auditor and supervisor. He also was the auditor for the Kroger Credit Union. After retirement from the Kroger Co., Perry and his wife owned and operated the Yacht Haven Marina in Lake of the Ozark, MO, for three years. Later they moved to Sebring, FL, where they lived for five years, before returning to Toledo. Perry was a life-long member of the Church of Christ and was actively involved with the local Church, wherever he lived. He was treasurer and trustee for the Whitney Hills Church of Christ in Toledo, for twelve years, and was instrumental in setting up the "Bible Call" program at Echo Meadows Church of Christ, where he was a faithful member until his death. In addition to his wife, survivors include two nephews, Tim Tucker of Finland and Mark (Barbara) Tucker of Abilene, TX and sister-in-law, Edith Tucker of Nashville, TN. His sisters, Dollye DeMuth and Dale Blocker and a brother, Paul M. Tucker, preceded Perry in death. Friends are invited to visit from 4-8 p.m. Tuesday, in the Ansberg-West Funeral Home, 3000 Sylvania Avenue, (between Douglas and Secor Roads). Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m.
