



## Jack Adams

January 1, 1922 - June 27, 2022

Jack Adams passed away on Monday, June 27, 2022 in Toledo. Born January 1, 1922 to Harry and Martha Adamitis.

Jack immigrated to the USA from Athens, Greece, after the second World War. He was called to serve in the Greek Army, August 1947. Recruited in Athens, soon after he was assigned to serve as an Auditor in Corinth High Pelloponisos Army Headquarters. The Z! Branch was where all the entire expenditure of the combatant Greek Army was involved to repel the Northern Soviet Satellites invasion. Due to the intense growing struggle taking place, the Army had encountered lack of supplies due to slow approval of expenditures because of antiquated procedures. To expedite the method of approving the expenditures, Jack envisioned to change the old and substitute a new method. The scheme to abbreviate the procedure was sent to Athens to be studied by the authorities for approval. The highest command approved his plan and the problem was solved.

Jack soon learned the English language. He was accepted to the University of Toledo and graduated in 1963 with a Bachelor's degree in Education. He was sponsored by his uncle, who helped him attend the University financially. He taught Mathematics at Washington Junior High, Scott High School and Woodward High School. He also worked at Jeep to be able to continue his studies. He spoke five languages, which he learned in Greece.

Jack retired in 1988 and pursued collecting and dealing antiques with the help of his wife, Jessica. Finally, they retired in 2003.

He was a member of Mason Lodge 144 in Toledo, He earned his 32nd degree and shrine. He was a member of Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Cathedral and known for being young at heart.

Jack is survived by his wife, Jessica, an aunt and many nieces and nephews in Greece and the United States.

Friends and family are invited to visit at Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Cathedral on Friday, July 1, 2022 at 10:00am, where a funeral service will begin at 11:00am. Interment will be 10:00am on Saturday, July 2, 2022, at Ottawa Hills Memorial Park.
