Former Rossford resident James William Miller passed away on Tuesday, February 2, at Hospice of Chattanooga, TN following a courageous battle with cancer. He was born on October 13, 1931 in Wood County Ohio to Stella (Kroetz) and Martin Miller. He was a 1949 graduate of Webster High School and later a graduate of The University of Toledo. After serving four years in the United States Air Force, he was employed for over 40 years at the Rossford plant of Libbey-Owens-Ford, now Pilkington, and in his later years was Superintendent of the Float Glass area.
