Dr. James Martin Redenbo was born on July 1st, 1938, and was received into the arms of his Savior Jesus Christ on June 3rd in his home surrounded by his loving family at 86 years old. He was a dedicated husband to his wife Judy, of 57 years, father & grandfather and devoted his life to the Lord, his family and service to others.

Born to Charlotte Foster and raised in Toledo, Ohio by his loving parents Roe and Cecilia Redenbo, James was a devout Christian who served at his local church. A patient teacher, tutor and friend, he shared his faith by distributing food to the poor and authored a book highlighting moments of his personal walk with God. He could do absolutely anything and was known for his kindness and eagerness to help others. He had a witty sense of humor and loved to make people laugh.

After graduating from the University of Toledo in 1964 he received his PhD in Biophysics and Physical Chemistry from the University of Illinois in 1968. James spent most of his career in Computer Programming and teaching at Drake University and Owens Community College.
