Jennifer A. Wenzke, 62, passed away on June 7, 2017 peacefully in her home surrounded by her loving family and friends after a long struggle with ALS. She and her family later moved to Bowling Green, Ohio where she graduated from Bowling Green High School, class of 1972, and Bowling Green State University class of 1978. In 2010, Jennifer began a networking group called SoNow. Her goal was to help 10,000 women. This was her dream job and she opened locations in Lima, Perrysburg, Finlay, and Sylvania. Jennifer was also involved with Mary Kay Cosmetics for 22 years and served as a Senior Sales Director. She loved playing the flute and sat first chair in her high school band. She was also an avid fan of ice skating and travelled to watch live championships whenever possible.
