John Richard Badhorn, age 90, passed away Friday May 20, 2016. He was born July 5, 1925 to Harry John and Marie (Erard) Badhorn in Toledo.

John was a member of the 1943 graduating class of Central Catholic High School. He is a veteran of World War II having enlisted in the United States Army in 1944. During the war he served in France, Germany, and the Philippines, as well as, in Japan and the Panama Canal post war.
