Jacky and Joyce were totally devoted to each other for 45 years. Each one of them always looked at each other with love in their eyes. They cherished each other and cared for each other every day that they were together. They had no children, but nurtured their nieces and nephews, and in the recent past, rescued a ferrel cat from the freezing cold. This tiny kitty became a loving house cat that brought them so much joy.

Our sister was beautiful inside and out and was a very loving and compassionate person. Anyone who knew her loved her because she was always available to listen, give, guide, and inspire. Empathy and kindness were just two of her many virtues. She was fun and fun loving, yet serious. Whatever she started, she finished.
