Kay Ann Clawson, 68, of Toledo unexpectedly passed away Sunday, November 22, 2015 at St. Vincent Hospital in the company of her loving husband and family members.

Kay was born May 11, 1947 in Saginaw, Michigan to Kenneth and Elaine Doehring. Following the death of Kenneth Doehring, Kay and her siblings were adopted by Franklin Brooks of Saginaw, Michigan.

Kay held a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration from Bowling Green State University and an Associate of Arts Degree majoring in Dance from Macomb College. Kay was a Certified Credit Executive.

Kay was employed since 2004 as the program accountant with Lucas County Metropolitan Housing Authority. Kay held prior sales and accounting positions at Credit Bureau of Findlay, TRW, Data Rentals, Toledo Opera and Toledo Repertory Theater. Kay was honored to be a facilitator at the American Institute of CPAs Global Manufacturing Conference in Denver, Colorado in September, 2015.

Kay was recognized in April, 2002 with a Women of Toledo award. She was President of Toledo Senior Centers, Inc. in 2000-2001, President of the Women of the Old West End in 1998-2000.
