



## Kevin M. Corrigan

January 10, 1955 - May 15, 2021

Kevin M. Corrigan, 66, of Toledo, passed away unexpectedly on Saturday, May 15, 2021. He was born in Toledo on January 10, 1955 to Raymond and Eleanor (Kreuz) Corrigan. He was the fifth child in a family of eight children. He attended Blessed Sacrament Elementary School and graduated from Central Catholic High School in 1973. He attended the University of Toledo where he was a member of Phi Kappa Psi fraternity and then pursued a career in business.

With an aptitude for sales, Kevin worked with leading automotive service suppliers including divisions of Dana Corporation and major automotive parts retailers. He eventually worked his way up to Division Manager of Northern US and Canada for Luberfiner with Champion Laboratories. He retired from Luberfiner in January of 2020.

Known for his easygoing nature, generosity, and charm, Kevin was loved by all. He enjoyed spending his time grilling, golfing, and relaxing with his dogs, Petey and Tommy Girl. He was best known, not for a loud laugh or a punchy story, though he offered both, but for his genuine interest in the well-being of others and his calm, soaking-it-all-in presence.

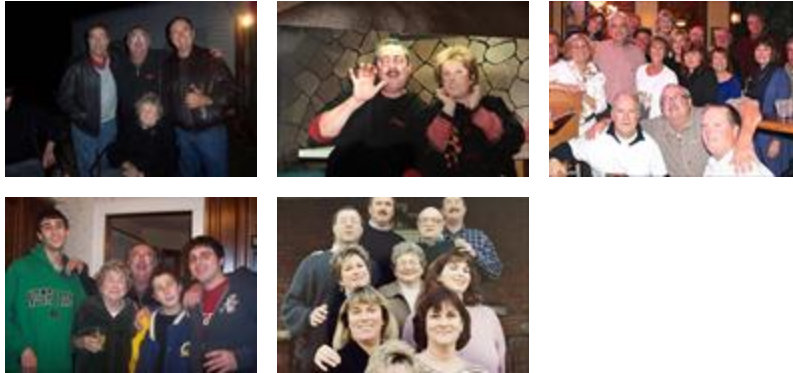
