December 28, 1916 - July 19, 2009

Leland E. MacDonald, 92, passed away Sunday at Kingston in Perrysburg. He was born December 28, 1916 to Ewen and Essie MacDonald in Toledo. Leland was a graduate of Waite High School, class of 1934. He honorably served his country in the Army during World War II. Leland was a 32nd degree mason and was a member of the Zenobia Shrine bagpipers group. He retired from the Local 55 Iron Workers after being a longtime member. He served as the foreman of the construction crew during the building of the Apollo launch pad #39 at Cape Canaveral. He was a member of Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Cathedral where he was a member of the young at heart club. Leland is survived by his loving wife of 72 years, Mary; children, Leland "Nick" (Sue) MacDonald, Kathy (John) Horvath, Pete (Deb) MacDonald; 11 grandchildren and 9 great grandchildren.
