June 21, 1928 - December 15, 2017

Leo Campbell, 89, passed away peacefully in his sleep on Friday December 15th, 3 months after having a stroke. He grew up in Toledo, and was a proud graduate of Libbey High School Class of 1946, and the University of Toledo.
