Leonard J. Pietkowski, 87, passed away on December 3, 2008 in his Toledo residence. He was born in Toledo on September 6, 1921 to Joseph and Caroline Pietkowski. He was a graduate of Woodward High School and attended the University of Toledo. During his youth, he was very proud to be an Eagle Scout. He served his country honorably during WWII as a first lieutenant with the Army Transportation Corp where he traveled the world transporting troops, arms, and supplies. He was a lifelong member of the Disabled American Veterans. He returned to Toledo after the war and followed in his fathers footsteps becoming a second generation Toledo Fire Fighter.
