Lloyd Morimoto, 88, passed away peacefully in his sleep on May 6, 2025. He was a third-generation Japanese-American, also known as a “Sansei.” Lloyd lived a life of resilience, love, and a playful spirit that touched everyone around him.

He was born in Pasadena, California. As a young person, Lloyd endured the injustices of the Japanese American incarceration camps during World War II. He later served in the U.S. Army—a powerful testament to his strength of character. He used the GI Bill and graduated in 1961 from Fenn College (now Cleveland State University) with a Bachelor of Business Administration.

He was known for his sharp mind, goofy sense of humor, and deep kindness. Lloyd worked for over 30 years at Penske, where he was respected as a dedicated and hardworking employee. A devoted father, loving grandfather, loyal brother, and cherished friend, his warmth and wisdom will be missed beyond measure.

Lloyd was son to Fred Hanji Morimoto and Carolyn Misao Morimoto and the beloved husband of his late wife, Sharon. He is survived by his children, Rachel, Elise, and Douglas; his son-in-law, Mark and daughter-in-law, Casey; his grandchildren, Madison, Emily, Mason, Allen, and Braylen; his brother, Richard; and his dear friend and sister-in-law, Barb.
