Martha Lucille (McCollum) Marion, age 93, was received into the everlasting arms of her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on February 12, 2016. Martha was the daughter of Matthew McCollum and Alice Wilson and loving wife of James Francis Marion (deceased). She is survived by her daughter, Sharon; her son, Donald Gary; granddaughters, Rebecca and Rachel Marion; and her daughter-in-law, June Zenner Marion.

Although born in Berea, Kentucky, on August 30, 1922, Martha was raised in Loyal, Kentucky, and was graduated from Loyal High School. The couple resettled in Toledo, Ohio, where they later celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary December 1994.
