Minutes before midnight on Saturday, January 31, Mary F. (Gillig) Ensman, age 85, passed away peacefully at the Toledo Hospital. Mary, the youngest of 4 daughters, was born on August 21, 1923 to Arthur and Florence (Bennett) Gillig. Mary met and married James F. Ensman on October 15, 1949 who preceded her in death in 1974. Their union produced two sons who survive - Martin (Annette) Ensman of Temperance, MI and Thomas (Mary) Ensman of Toledo. Mary was preceded in death by her three sisters, Helen Lourcey, Kathryn Murphy and Margaret Polito.
