Merritt R. Facer, 87, of Toledo, passed away Saturday, May 16, 2009, at The Toledo Hospital. He was born August 4, 1921, in Toledo and was the son of Orville and Elsie Facer. Merritt was a graduate of Waite High School and played on the 1939 State Championship football team. He was a University of Toledo graduate and served honorably in the Army as a staff sergeant, during WW II. Merritt was a supervisor at Libbey Owens Ford, for 34 years, before retiring.
