Born on Wednesday, November 2, 1988, at 2:19pm, after a three-day struggle to come into this world. He definitely was a beloved son, grandson, nephew, cousin, uncle "brother," and friend.

Michael's creativity, humor, loving and outgoing grind nature made him into Mike Flamez, the MC, lyricist, wordologist poet and a master at spittin' bars. He was a friend who had the ability to connect and bring laughter to any room he walked into. His closest friends were more than friends, they were family.

Michael's passions were not only noticed by being an MC, but he was also a talented photographer, graphic designer, charitable organizer, actor and sports fanatic.
