Michael J. Quinn, 81, of Toledo, passed away Monday, July 2, 2007, at his home. He was born in County Roscommon, Ireland, on August 25, 1925 and was the son of Thomas and Delia (Kilcourse) Quinn. Mike was very proud of his Irish heritage. He left Ireland in 1941 and worked in England during WWII and came to the United States in 1948. Mike was the owner and operator of Quinn Concrete, which he founded in 1973. He was a member of Regina Coeli Catholic Church and was a longtime member of the Cement Masons, Local #886.
