September 14, 1922 - January 1, 2011

Nancy (Nafsika) Proestou, a resident of Toledo, went to meet the Lord on January 1, 2011 following a brief illness with cancer. Born September 14, 1922 in Sysklipos, Cyprus, Nancy immigrated to the United States with her family in 1968. In 1970, she began her long career as a seamstress. She was employed by Bridal Isle, by Lion Store at the Westgate Shopping Center and the Franklin Park Mall, and then by Dillards, until her retirement in 1998. She enjoyed spending time with her family and friends and loved to travel. She was a member of the Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Cathedral in Toledo, the Philoptochos Society, the Daughters of Penelope and the Young at Heart organizations at the Cathedral. She volunteered endlessly her many talents to the Church.
