O. Leland Floyd, 102 years old of Toledo, OH passed away Tuesday, January 23, 2024, in Temperance, MI. He was born October 27, 1921, in Sand Fork, WV to Bryson and Merle (Herron) Floyd. He graduated from Sand Ford High School in 1940.
